1. **Davis-Putter Scholarship Fund**

Deadline: Apr. 1

Award: Up to \$10,000

Scholarship Overview: Open to students able to do academic work at the college or university level or are enrolled in a trade or technical program and who are active in the progressive movement. Students must also demonstrate financial need.

Deadline: Apr. 1

Award: Up to \$20,000 over 4 years
