1. **Patsy Takemoto Mink Education Foundation Support Awards**

Deadline: Aug. 1

Award: Up to \$5,000

Scholarship Overview: Open to low-income women that are at least 17 years old with children. Applicant must be pursuing a vocational degree/certificate, associate's degree, first bachelor's degree, or a professional/master's/doctoral degree
