1. MIT Think Scholars Program

Deadline: Jan. 1, 2019

Award: Up to \$500

Scholarship Overview: Open to full-time high school students attending a public, private, or home school. Applicants must submit a proposal for a STEM project focused on solving a problem of the student's choice. Selected winners will have a chance to work on completing their project with guidance from the THINK team at MIT.

2. GE – Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program

Deadline: Jan. 4, 2019

Award: \$10,000

Scholarship Overview: Open to high school seniors who demonstrate leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship at school, at the workplace, and in the community. Applicant must also demonstrate financial need.
