### I. MIT Think Scholars Program

Deadline: Jan. 1, 2019 Award: Up to \$500

**Scholarship Overview:** Open to full-time high school students attending a public, private, or home school. Applicants must submit a proposal for a STEM project focused on solving a problem of the student's choice. Selected winners will have a chance to work on completing their project with guidance from the THINK team at MIT.

## 2. GE - Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program

**Deadline**: lan. 4, 2019 **Award**: \$10,000
