1. **American Chemical Society Scholarship**

Deadline: Mar. 1, 2019

Award: \$5,000

Scholarship Overview: Open to African American, Hispanic, or American Indian high school seniors or college freshman, sophomores, or juniors pursuing a college degree in the chemical sciences or chemical technology.
